

Dissemination of the fourth project meeting in Tolox - Spain
5.05 – 10.05.2014



Tuesday, 6th May, 2014

We were welcomed very warmly by our hosts from C.E.I.P. SAN ROQUE. There was a speech made by the mayor of Tolox, the head teacher and the Spanish team. The coordinator presented his students. Each country presented its own Comenius team. We visited school and got to know each other. We could admire a huge poster showing Europe and flags of each country involved in the project. The poster was made by our Spanish friends.

Each team presented the video collection of traditional music and dances. The videos were rewarded by thunderous applause. We were very proud of our traditional music, dance and national costumes.

We also presented photos of modern sculptures and crafts having its roots in folklore. Each team made a panel with the photos they bring to Spain. All the panels made a huge exhibition. Thanks to those photos we could better know partners' tradition.





Wednesday, 7th May, 2014

On the third day there was a documentation trip to Grenada. We had a tour of the historic downtown. We visited Alhambra and Generalife which are the country's most significant and well know Islamic architecture. They are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We could admire breathtaking view from the towers of the castle.



Thursday, 8th May, 2014

The day started with a work session. The students working in mixed teams selected the photos to make a calendar for 2015. The calendar contains information about the most important events in each partner country and photos from the exhibition, that represent crafts and

sculptures which are inspired by traditions. Each team chose the best photos and together with their teachers created the calendar called *TRADITION – CRAFT*. In the afternoon we had a documentation trip to Malaga. We visited the Folk Art Museum. We could observe how Spain has changed through the ages. We visited the Cathedral of Malaga. It has influences of the renaissance and baroque styles. Then we saw the Alcazaba which is a palatial fortification. This is the best preserved citadel in Spain.



Friday, 9th May, 2014

The fourth day we started with the visit to the Tolox Spa Resort located in the Sierra de las Nieves Nature Reserve (Biosphere Reserve). The place is famous for treating patients having problems with asthma. Then we had a tour of Tolox. We visited The House Museum of Arts and Popular Traditions. Through their furniture, tools and pictures of people and streets, it recreates the typical village life in late 19th century.

Our Spanish hosts organized incredible show presenting *Flamenco* dance and music. We could feel southern rhythms. The professional dance instructor from the school gave us some clues how to dance flamenco. The Spanish students also offered us modern dances inviting everybody to take part in full of the joy of meeting people of different cultures.

Traditional Spanish *paella* was served. That was the best culmination of the last day in Spain. We evaluated the fourth project meeting in Spain.
