Dissemination of the second project meeting in Istanbul - Turkey 25.11 - 30.11.2013



Tuesday, 26th November, 2013

The teachers and the students were welcomed by the head teacher and students of TAYFUN TOPÇU ANADOLU LİSESİ. We visited our partner's school. The Head Official introduced his district. We were welcomed traditionally with Turkish tea.

It was a very good example of Turkish national heritage. We discussed about their rich history and influence on other nations. We also talked about common points in historical and religious aspect. In the afternoon, video collection of traditions that people have at important events in their lives was displayed. All the partners had a question- answer session in order to clarify all issues connected with the topic. We evaluated all collection and students' work on it.





Thursday, 28th November, 2013

There was a documentation trip to Miniaturk and Panorama Museum in connection to our project. We had a guided tour of small miniatures of all castles, mosques, churches, historical and places of interest, natural attractions and other architectures in Turkey. Then, we had opportunity to observe some lessons in Turkish school. We could compare their teaching techniques with ours. After a short break the students presented their Power Point presentations on customs, beliefs when human beings are born, get married, have children or die. Now we could sum up all of them. As after the firs part we discovered that we already have a lot of common points from past till now about our tradition.
