

# "Let's First Understand Our National Heritage in order to Define and Build Our European Identity", A Comenius Multilateral School Partnership(2013-2015)

## EVALUATION REPORT ON THE 5<sup>th</sup> COMENIUS MEETING IN GREECE

This report is to evaluate the meeting in Greece from the teachers' and students' point of view.

## TEACHERS

## $1^{st}$ and $2^{nd}$ question

When asked to what extent the project issues are important in consideration with globalization, <u>54%</u> answered <u>very much</u> and <u>46% quite a lot</u>. When they were asked to specify why some of them asked that it is a way to make people get to know each other and that we cannot live in isolation.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> question

When asked if their students have reflected positive attitudes related to topics covered in this project,73% answered very much, 7% quite a lot, 13% slightly and 7% not at all.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> question

When asked which part they consider most valuable for their students,<u>47%</u> answered <u>Delivering their presentations</u>,<u>27%</u> said <u>going abroad</u> as members of their country's project, <u>13%</u> said <u>working in groups</u> and another <u>13%</u> suggested <u>something else</u>.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> question (more than one options)

When asked what school subjects their students' knowledge has been improved owing to their participation in this project, <u>100%</u> said <u>foreign languages</u>,<u>67%</u> said <u>geography</u>, <u>20%</u> <u>history</u>, <u>20%</u> their own language and <u>7%</u> said <u>music and literature</u>.

## 6<sup>th</sup> question

100% of the teachers answered that the students' involvement in the project was useful.

## 7<sup>th</sup> question

In this question they were asked to answer what and to what extent they have improved.

- The use of innovation and classroom activities(40%-very much, 33%-quite a lot, 27%-slightly)
- The use of new ICT tools (40%-very much, 20%-quite a lot, 33%-slightly, 7%-not at all)
- Planning and organizational skills (20%-very much, 80%-quite a lot)
- Awareness of different cultures (70%-Very much, 30%-quite a lot)
- Awareness of the European dimension in Education (80%-very much, 20%-quite a lot)
- Communication Skills (90%-Very much, 10%-Quite a lot)

## 8<sup>th</sup> question

When asked if they would lend support to another Comenius/Erasmus project, 100% answered positively.

## STUDENTS

## 1<sup>st</sup> question

When asked to what extent the project issues are important in consideration with globalization, <u>28%</u> answered <u>very much</u>, <u>54%</u> <u>quite a lot</u> and <u>18%</u> answered <u>slightly</u>

## 2<sup>nd</sup> question

When asked if they have reflected positive attitudes related to the topics covered in the project, <u>7%</u> answered <u>Very much</u>, <u>25%</u> said <u>quite a lot</u> and <u>68%</u> said <u>slightly</u>.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> question (more than one options)

When asked which part they consider most valuable their answers were as follows:

- Preparing Presentations-3%
- Delivering Presentations-8%
- Going on local trips-54%
- Going abroad as members of the country's team-25%
- Working in mixed groups-10%
- Others-0%

#### 4<sup>th</sup> question (more than one options)

When asked which subjects their knowledge has been improved owing to their participation in this project, the answers were the following:

- Foreign Languages-85%
- Geography-75%
- History-80%
- ICT-25%

- Your own language-13%
- Others-0%

#### 5<sup>th</sup> question

<u>100%</u> answered that the project was <u>useful</u>.

#### 6<sup>th</sup> question

When asked what and to what extent they have improved thanks to the project, they answered as follows:

- The use of new ICT tools: Very Much-22%, Quite a lot-15%, Slightly-27%, Not at all-36%
- Awareness of different cultures: Very Much-75%, Quite a lot-25%
- Communication Skills: Very Much-84%, Quite a lot-8%, Slightly-8%

#### 7<sup>th</sup> question

100% answered positively when asked if they would lend their support to another Comenius project.

#### FILM PRESENTATIONS

On an overall discussion on what the most striking elements in the films were, Estonia's film entails positive meanings and showed them that "Good" is always the winner.
