

**Dissemination of the eighth project meeting in Lohusuu, Estonia  
4.05– 9.05.2015**



**Tuesday, 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2015**

We were welcomed by the head teacher of *Lohusuu Kool* and the representative from the local municipality. They opened the last project meeting. Then, as usual, we started our work.
